Official and International Agreements

From the year of 2002 our Institution has been accredited by two well respected and important Universities, The al-Azhar University in Cairo, Egypt and The al-Fatah International University of Islamic Studies in Damascus.

We give our students the chance to continue their studies in these two important institutions.

First with Damascus University

In September of 2001 Antonio Romero, Director of the Faculty of Andalusian Studies signed an agreement with Dr. Husam ad-Din Farfur, director of al-Fatah International University of Islamic Studies in Damascus.

The agreement includes academic and cultural collaboration between the two institutions.

Our degree courses are four years and we use the accreditation system wich is used through-out Europe.

Courses

We run two Intensive Courses of Two weeks, One month or two month duration.

Arabic Courses

We teach Introduction, Intermediary and advances level in the arabic language. These certificated courses are recognised and valid in the University of Granada. This enables students to recive credits from the University and furthers them on in their chosen areas.





The classes are done in Arabic, Spanish and English and the professors do exchange visits between the three Institutions. The exams are valid in all three institutions regardless of where they were taken from within the three faculties. This means our students can increase and complement their knowledge by being able to attend the three different faculties.



With the assistance of recognised and qualified teachers and lecturers from other institutions (both from within and outside of Spain) who specialise in Islamic studies we are able to offer comprehensive courses.



Due to the history and the geographical situation of Spain, there exists a necessity to know, understand and study the Arabic language and Islamic culture.



The Faculty works intensively to bring knowledge and information to young people of today recognising that they are our future and the future of Islam in Europe.

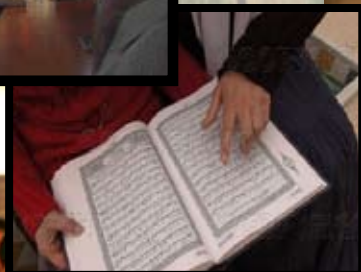
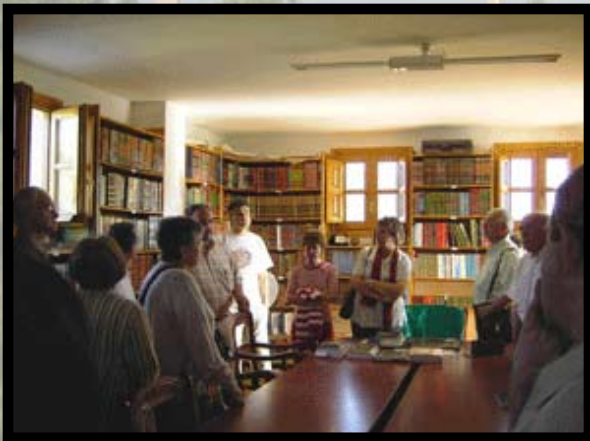
Islamic Courses

We use a combination of modern technologies and the traditional methods of learning to teach our students in a relaxing and conducive environment.

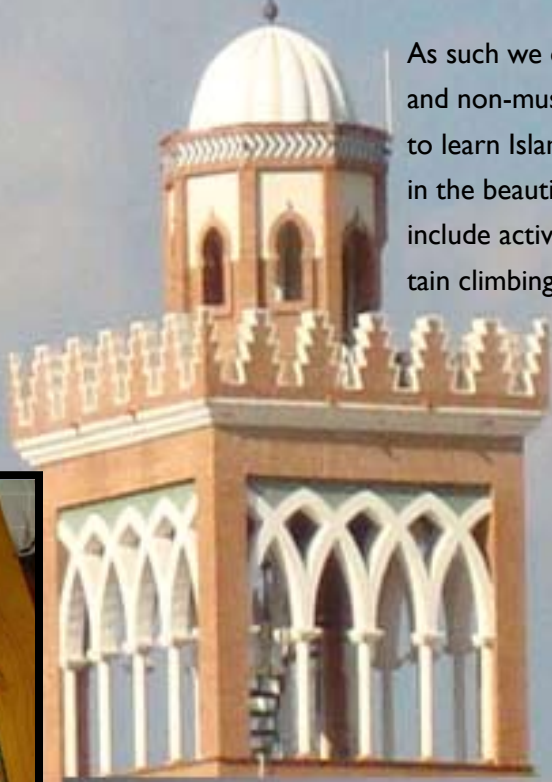
